Application for an Aden Government Scholarship.

Reference your letter of application dated 28th February, 1957.

I have pleasure in informing you that Government has agreed that you be awarded a scholarship to take a degree in Arts at the American University of Beirut. It is proposed that you should proceed to Beirut in the autumn of 1958.

This award is subject to your possessing the necessary entrance qualifications to the University and to a place being found for you there.

It should also be understood that before proceeding abroad for your course, you will be required to sign an Agreement that you will be prepared to serve Government for five years following the completion of your course.

I now enclose the following documents:

4 Copies of particulars of Candidate, 4 Copies of Appendix B thereof, 2 copies of Medical certificate of fitness and a letter to the Director of Medical Services,

1 Entrance form for the University of Beirut.

Please take the 2 copies of the Medical Certificate of Fitness together with the letter to the Director of Medical Services to the Civil Hospital and make an appointment for a medical examination. It is necessary for you to write and let me know when this takes place.

I must also ask you to complete the 4 copies of Particulars of Candidate together with the Appendices thereof and the Entrance Form for the University of Beirut and return them to me with the following:

4 Passpirt photographs,
1 Copy of Birth Certificate,
copies of all educational certificates you may have and
details of all educational qualifications you may hold for
which certificates are awaited and examinations which you
plan to sit for before your departure to Beirut.

The above documents should be returned to me at your earliest convenience.

- (a) he completes his prescribed studies and passes his prescribed examination without his scholarship being suspended or terminated in the circumstances set out in clause 2 of the said AGREEMENT, and thereafter complies with the declaration at the foot of the said AGREEMENT as to subsequent service with Government, or
- (b) If the scholar deposits with Government the sum of Shs.1500/- in manner prescribed in clause 3 of the said AGREEMENT, or
- (c) If on suspension or termination of the scholarship in the circumstances set out in clause 2 of the said AGREEMENT, the scholar pays for his own passage from the United Kingdom to the Colony.

ACCEPTANT COVERING THE AWARD OF A GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

- The Scholar is required to :-
 - (a) to devote his whole time to following the course of instruction for which the scholarship is awarded, unless permission to undertake other work or to change his course is granted by the Director of Colonial Scholars with the approval of the Government of Aden;
 - (b) to sit for prescribed examination of approved groups of examinations;
 - (c) to reside in a approved College or hostel. The prior consent of the Government of Aden must be given through the College or other appropriate authority before a student may live in private lodgings or a private flat;
 - (d) to satisfy the Director of Colonial Scholars as to attendance conduct and progress by reports from the head of institutions or otherwise.
- A scholarship may be suspended or terminated by Government if:-
 - (a) reports on the students work or conduct are unsatisfactory;
 - (b) a student, without reasonable excuses, fails to pass a prescribed examination within the time fixed by the authorities of the institution which he is attending, or by the Director of Colonial Scholars;
 - a student engaged in any occupation other that his scholarship studies without the written consent of the Director of Colinal (c) a student becomes unfit to complete his studies ewing to illnessor is absent from his studies for more than six months owing to

- (e) Without the written permission of Government, a student marries during and before completion of the course of his studies (including the passing of any required examination) for which the scholarship has been newarded.
- The Scholar shall deposit with Covernment Shs.1,500/- (Shillings one thousand five mindred only) in cash or give secubity for that sum in the form of a bond (to be approved by Government) at the time of signing the contract. This sum, or such part of it as may be required for that purpose may be used by Government to meet the expenses of the Scholars return journey from the United Kingdom to the Colony in the circumstances set out in clause 2 hereof except in the case of a scholarship being suspended on terminated on the 3. in the case of a scholarship being suspended or terminated on the groups of ill health for which the Scholar cannot be held reasonable, A part from this use to which the money may be put by Government, Government may utlike it in payment of any damages or expenses to which Government may be put as the result of any breach of this agreement by the Scholar, and for this purpose Sh. 1,500/- (Shilling one thousand five hundred only) is agreed as liquidated damages, should the Scholar fail to take employment under Government in the circumstances and in manner provided in the declaration and agreement at the foot hereof, or should be resign from or terminate such serviduring the first 4 years thereof. The deposit shall be retainable by Government until the expiration of 5 years or earlier termination of this agreement.
- Should the Scholar without reasonable excuse, when required to return from the United Kingdom to Aden under and in pursuance of the 4. provisions of this agreement fails to do so in manner required by Government, any allowance which may become payable to him subsequent to the date so fixed for his deparature may be withheld.
 - In the United Kingdom the student will be under the charges directions and control of the Director of Colonial Scholars.

- Financial arrangements for the payment of the scholarship grants in the United Kingdom will be made by the Director of Colonial scholars.
- 7. The student will be required to pass a medical examination before selection and may be required to submit to an annual medical examination during the tenure of the scholarship.
- 8. Financial assistance from Government funds will not be given to the wife, children or other dependant of a Scholar to accompany him to, or join him in, the United Kingdom unless Government permission has been given.

I, SULTAN ABDO NAGI

hereby declare that I have read these rules. I admowledge that in accepting this sward, I take advantage of public funds in order to complete the said training and I agree, on completion of the training, to serve/ to continue to serve the Government of Aden for a period of five years in a capacity for which the training has qualified se, and provided opportunity to serve is saide available to me within a period of six months after the completion of the training, on the usual terms of Government service in respect to such employment.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

In your letters of 29th March 1957, 18th September, 1957 22nd October, 1957 and 14th April 1958, you drew attention to the fact that, as a result of an anomaly in the Salaries Revision, 1956, you were placed, on conversion to the revised salary scale D1/2, in a more unfavourable position than that of other teachers with similar qualifications who were recruited into the service on or after 1st April 1957.

I have pleasure in informing you that Government has agreed to the rectification of this anomaly by giving approval for you to be paid at the rate of £366. per annum with effect from 1st September 1956 (the date of your appointment) and at the rate of £381. per annum with effect from 1st September 1957.

The arrears of salary will be paid to you as soon as possible.


